Description: The FR-300 can also be used in toxic atmospheres thanks

to its independence from recirculated air, making it an ideal

ventilator for fire departments in the event of fire or

hazardous goods incidents.

If the patient suddenly starts breathing spontaneously, additional oxygen is automatically supplied via the "demand

valve".

This means that breathing in ambient atmosphere is 100% impossible. The

rescuers do not have to make any adjustments.

The device automatically recognizes the optimum ventilation volume for each patient thanks to its automatic pressure/flow system. The Oxylator FR-300 can be connected directly to the patient's mask or by means of a goose gurgle.
